Latest information on COVID-19 Outbreak in Shepparton

There are three new cases of people that have tested positive for COVID-19 in the Shepparton region that are considered to be active cases. These three cases are linked to the Chadstone Outbreak.

These people are self-isolating at home and are being monitored.

GV Health is undertaking contact tracing now and into the evening, with further information to be provided as soon as it is available.

If you have visited any of the high-risk locations below during the dates and times identified you should get tested and quarantine for 14 days. Even if you don't have any symptoms or only mild symptoms.
